Organizational Design & Structures: Basic Concepts, types of organizational structure; functional structure, product structure, geographic structure & matrix structure. Virtual structure, Informal organization.

UNIT-III Staffing: Concept, Objective of staffing, System approach to staffing, Manpower planning. Directing: Concept, Supervision, Types of supervision, Essential characteristics of supervisor

Motivation: Concept, Need for motivation. Theories of motivation

UNIT-IV Concept of Leadership, Theories and Styles, Importance of leadership, Characteristics of an effective leader. Manager vs. leader.

Controlling: Basic Concepts, Elements of Managerial Control, Management Control Techniques, Effective Control Systems. Forward, backward and concurrent control. Budget as a control tool. Efficiency & effectiveness. (16 Contact Hours)
